



## **Voices: Chicago Jewish Teen Foundation 2025-2026 Request for Proposal Israel Committee**

**Voices: The Chicago Jewish Teen Foundation** is comprised of a group of Chicago-area Jewish teenagers from a variety of backgrounds. The Foundation focuses on different philanthropic needs each year. We are funded by a special endowment through the Jewish Federation of Metropolitan Chicago as well as our own contributions. This year, Voices 101 members divided into committees based upon four different areas of interest: combating antisemitism, economic justice, Israel, and violence prevention.

### **Mission Statement**

*The Voices 101 board is devoted to making a positive impact by supporting organizations that value equity, service, and community through combating antisemitism, working to prevent violence and build economic equity, and support Israel.*

This Request for Proposal (RFP) represents the grant guidelines and funding goals of the **Israel Committee**.

### **What is Funded?**

In the 2025-2026 year, Voices: The Chicago Jewish Teen Foundation's **Israel Committee** will fund organizations that support individuals affected by terror in Israel, support community building activities in Israel, and provide and support education about Israel.

Examples of services funded by this committee include:

1. Israel education
2. Services for individuals trying to make *aliyah* to Israel
3. Supporting victims of terror and the reintegration of IDF soldiers into day-to-day life
4. Serving marginalized communities in Israel
5. Peacebuilding efforts

### **What is Not Funded?**

We will not accept proposals requesting funding for:

1. Organizations solely focused on humanitarian relief
2. Organizations or projects that not in or for Israel
3. Ideas/philosophies not supported by Voices: The Chicago Jewish Teen Foundation

*Priority will be given to Jewish Organizations.*

*Grant-seeking organizations may apply for funding from up to two committees across both boards, provided each application is for a different funding need.*

*Organizations that have applied for or received funds in previous years are welcome to reapply.*
